**1/2 day - 3 hour class
All Skill Levels**

Is color choice difficult for you? In this ½ day class, we will explore simple color theory as it relates to quilting. The class will begin with a short lecture on what makes an effective quilt, combining design, color, texture, contrast, and value. Students work through a variety of exercises that will stretch the imagination. This popular class features lots of student interaction as we play with fabric! No sewing machine, and no UFO to take home.

One iron for every 2-3 students and six foot tables with no more than two students to a table; enough electrical outlets and extension cords to provide power to each sewing machine and iron.
