

INTRODUCTION TO FREEZER PAPER FOUNDATION PIECING

1/2 day - 3 hour class
All Skill Levels

Students will learn freezer paper foundation piecing, and curved seam assembly techniques, while at the same time, stitching a single block that can later be made into a tote bag or a larger, block repeat quilt.

A kit is provided for this class that includes the pattern (for a full size quilt), freezer paper, and all fabrics for one block (including the hand-dyed gradations).

The materials listed below will make one 12” quilt block.

Includes all fabric to make one block, including hand-dyed gradations for geese, and freezer paper

Fabric and paper scissors
Rotary cutting equipment
Basic sewing supplies
Sewing machine

Mechanical pencil
6” or 12” Add-a-Quarter ruler
4” square ruler

Classroom Needs:

One iron for every 2-3 students and six foot tables with no more than two students to a table; enough electrical outlets and extension cords to provide power to each sewing machine and iron.
