

## LITTLE GOOSE, LITTLE GOOSE, FLY AWAY HOME!

### 1 day - 6 hour class All Skill Levels

Students will learn drafting, freezer paper foundation piecing, and curved seam assembly techniques, while at the same time, stitching this adorable little wall hanging. It includes a tiny tree, a little house, and a flying goose strip. In the morning we'll learn to draft the various fillers that I use in my quilts, including Flying Geese, Pointy Dudes, Picket Fence, Mountains and Valleys, and more. Then, after lunch, we will sew, using what we've learned.

The list below includes the minimum fabric requirements. I strongly encourage you to bring a larger selection of fabrics to enable more creative freedom. As with all quilting projects, choosing good quality fabrics will ensure easier sewing and a more successful finished product. Choose 100% cottons and pre-wash them before class. Hand dyed and hand painted fabrics and batiks, work well for this type of quilt. Think "prints that read as solids" when making your selection. If you are unsure what to bring, bring extra! See you in class!

1/3 yard background (sky) fabric

1/8 yard tree fabric

1/4 yard border fabric

Assorted scraps for house, grass, & geese

Freezer paper

Fabric and paper scissors

Rotary cutting equipment

Sewing machine

Basic sewing supplies

\* Mechanical pencil

\* Good eraser

\* 4" square ruler

\* 1" x 6" or 1" x 12" transparent ruler

\* 6" or 12" Add-a-Quarter ruler

\* 24" or larger flexible curve

3 Custom buttons, 1" Or larger

\* **Specialty tools will be available for purchase in class.**

### Classroom Needs:

One iron for every 2-3 students and six foot tables with no more than two students to a table; enough electrical outlets and extension cords to provide power to each sewing machine and iron.
